ROCK – Richard Nicholson, 78, of Rock, died at his home on Saturday, April 11, 2026 surrounded by his family and friends. Born May 29, 1947, in Bluefield, he was the son of the late Clifton Nicholson and Windella Roberts Nicholson.

Mr. Nicholson was a former employee of the City of Matoaka Water and Sewer Treatment Plant. He served in the US Army in Vietnam, where he received the Bronze Star. He served in the 1st/150th West Virginia National Guard and retired after 27 years of service to his country. He received the Army Commendation Medal at Fort Lee for saving three children from a burning house trailer. In his spare time, he owned and restored classic cars. He loved spending time with his family and making people laugh.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, June Weese Nicholson; and one sister, Loretta Mae Nicholson.
