Ronald W. Brooks, 80, of Princeton died Sunday, March 22, 2015 at Princeton Community Hospital. Born September 4, 1934 at Bluefield he was the son of the late Ivory Whitten Brooks and Alma Williams Brooks.

He was a veteran of the West Virginia National Guard, former member of the Board of Directors of the Green Valley-Glenwood Public Service District and member of the Senior Citizens Bowling League at Mountaineer Lanes in Bluefield for many years. Mr. Brooks was a charter member of Maple View Church of Christ in Bluefield where he enjoyed singing in the choir and was honored to have donated the land where the church was built. Prior to his retirement 1987 from Norfolk Southern Railway, he was Supervisor of Material Management in Roanoke, VA. He was an avid West Virginia University sports fan.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his wife of sixty years, Lillie Mae Massie Brooks in 2013 and one granddaughter Jamie Bourne.
