



Rev. Ronald Miller

April 29, 1944 - September 1, 2022

PRINCETON – Rev. Ronald Miller, Jr., 78, of Princeton, went to be with the Lord on Thursday, September 1, 2022. He had been in declining health for the last several years, but continued his ministry until the end. Born April 29, 1944 in Parsons, he was the son of the late Ronald Miller, Sr. and Helen Hebb Miller.

On September 3, 1965 he married Linda Ashcraft, in Oakland, Maryland. He was a graduate of Parsons High School and Hobart Welding School and was a certified welder. He was an ordained Bishop with the Church of God, pastoring for 32 years at West Union, Moneta, Virginia, Glade Farms, Weyanoke, Maybeury, Clarksburg, and most recently, did Pastoral Care at Lifeline Princeton Church of God.

He loved God and his family. He was a role model husband, father and grandfather, and was a mentor to many. He loved the outdoors, working in the yard, garden and enjoyed WV football.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by son-in-law, William Addison; and brother-in-law, Thomas Collins.

Survivors include his wife of 57 years, Linda Miller; daughter, Beverly Addison of Conyers, GA; son, Steven Miller (Penny) of Kellysville; grandchildren,

Steven Miller, II of Princeton, Jenna Stowers (Ethan) of Bluefield and Emily Addison of Loganville, GA; sisters, Shirley Colbert (Gary) of Nutter Fort, Donna Collins of Princeton and Karen Simmons (Ronnie) of Belton, TX; and several nieces and nephews.
