



## Rosa Haga

January 11, 1933 - October 12, 2015

PRINCETON – Rosa Woodring Haga, 82, of Princeton, died Monday, October 12, 2015. Born January 11, 1933 at Lowe, WV, she was the daughter of the late Rev. Benjamin Alfred Woodring and Mary Lou White Woodring.

Rosa was an avid quilter and reader who loved the Lord, her husband and family and her church.
