



Rulah Prinzbach

February 25, 1949 - June 16, 2017

PRINCETON - Rulah A. Prinzbach, 68, of N. Wickham Avenue, Princeton, died Friday, June 16, 2017 in Princeton Community Hospital. Born February 25, 1949 in Princeton, she was the daughter of the late Vinson and Virginia Cline Bailey.

Rulah started her nursing career as an LPN in Sumter, SC in the early 1970's. She returned to her hometown of Princeton in 1983 and resumed her nursing practice at Princeton Community Hospital, obtained her RN degree and worked for 25 years; the latter of which, she was a critical care charge nurse. Her pride and joy were her children and grandchildren.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her older brother, Ralph Bailey.

Those left to cherish her memory include her younger brother, Ritz Bailey and wife Dorothy; her son, Charles Prinzbach and wife Julie and grandsons Hayden and Gavin; her daughter Toni Carroll and husband Sammy and granddaughter Makayla; and her best friend, Ibby Quesenberry.

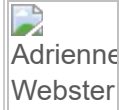
