PRINCETON – Shelby Jean Dishner, of Princeton, died Wednesday, January 12, 2022. Born in Piedmont, she was the daughter of the late Charles Robert Jefferson Dishner and Gladys Havannah Davis Dishner.

Shelby was a graduate of Matoaka High School, WV Business College and Bluefield State College. She taught for 28 years at Lashmeet Elementary School and was a member of CEOS Club through West Virginia University in Princeton. She worked for Roller Floral in Princeton for 14 years. She attended Lashmeet Community Freewill Baptist Church, where she sang in the choir, and later attended Rogers Street Community Church in Princeton.
