BRADENTON, FL - Sibyl Davis Wright, 97, of Bradenton, FL, formerly of Rock, went to her heavenly home Wednesday, December 16, 2020. Born September 8, 1923, she was the daughter of the late James Martin and Lucretia Wheeler Davis.

Sibyl was a lifelong member of Ashworth Memorial United Methodist Church in Matoaka. She was a proud West Virginian to her dying day.
