



Stuart Sigmon

January 29, 1941 - October 20, 2023

PRINCETON – James Stuart Sigmon, 82, of Princeton, died Friday, October 20, 2023 at Nelson’s Home Care. Born January 29, 1941 in Marion, VA, he was the son of the late Rev. James Edgar Sigmon and Bessie Allmon Sigmon.

Stuart was a graduate of Solanco High School in Quarryville, Pennsylvania and Campbellsville University in Campbellsville, Kentucky. Stuart was a former music teacher for Lebanon County Schools in Lebanon, Kentucky, Mercer County Schools in Princeton, and was former sales manager and general manager of Raines Music Center in Princeton. He retired as sales manager at Pounding Mill Quarry Corp. in Bluefield, Virginia. He was a past member of the Board of Directors for Bluefield Union Mission. Stuart was the former Minister of Music at First Baptist Church in Princeton for 40 years. He sang with “Three Hits and a Miss,” along with his wife, Dawn, Bill Winfrey and Earl Davis.

Survivors include his wife of 52 years, Dawn Catron Sigmon; one brother, Ray Sigmon and wife Barbara of Buford, GA; sister-in-law, Barbara Clark of Atkins, VA; brother-in-law, Bill Catron of Atkins, VA; and numerous nieces and nephews.
