BEESON – Theodore F. Shrewsbury, 94, of Beeson, died Saturday, October 29, 2011 at Rockin Chair Residential Care at Lerona. Born July 23, 1917 at Springton, he was the son of the late George Ballard Shrewsbury and Clarrie Cleo Huffman Shrewsbury.
