



Tressie Shrader

January 28, 1929 - February 3, 2015

PRINCETON – Tressie Shrader, 86 of Princeton, died Tuesday, February 3, 2015 at Carilion Giles Community Hospital in Pearisburg, VA. Born January 28, 1929 at Dublin, VA, she was the daughter of the late Dewey Roscoe Quesenberry and Dorothy Turpin Quesenberry.

After moving to Princeton from Hillsville, Virginia, Mrs. Shrader worked for Maidenform in Princeton. She was a member of Sandlick United Methodist Church for more than 60 years where she taught Sunday School for over 30 years. She enjoyed her flower garden.

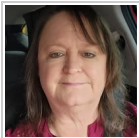
