PRINCETON – Boyce Wayne Sizemore, 66, of Princeton died Wednesday, February 20, 2013 at Carilion Roanoke Memorial Hospital in Roanoke, VA. Born February 2, 1947 at New Richmond he was the son of the late Charley H. Sizemore and Rosa Gay Blankenship Sizemore Gill.
