PRINCETON – Wesley B. Wyatt, 74, of Princeton, died Wednesday, February 23, 2011 at Bowers Hospice House in Beckley. Born November 23, 1936 at Murdock, he was the son of Toddie Bailey Schulz of Princeton and the late Walter Wyatt.

Mr. Wyatt was a veteran of the U.S. Navy and U.S. Army having served in Vietnam. He was a retired disabled miner and was a member of the U.M.W.A. He was of the Baptist faith. He was a member of the Mercer County Trappers Association and also taught gun classes and hunter safety classes.

In addition to his father, he was preceded in death by one son, John Wesley Wyatt; and one sister, Mary Crotty.
